Our Context

Prahran High School is a uniquely urban, inner-city 7-12 co-education school environment. Situated on busy High Street, Windsor, we are well serviced by public transport – trams, trains and buses all within easy walking distance. With no car parking on site, this ease of access is important and helpful. Most students who attend our school reside within the local community area, meaning that walking and bicycle riding are also convenient.

Our school is a purpose-built, vertical campus in one of Melbourne's most creative and eclectic inner-city urban villages. Our school is built to accommodate approximately 650 secondary students and is integrated into Prahran's thriving education and arts precinct that includes the Melbourne Polytechnic, Todd Patrick School of Dance, Gymnastics Victoria, and the National Institute of Circus Arts (NICA).

Spanning four levels that encircle a vast lightfilled central atrium, our school truly presents as an innovative, unique and contemporary school campus. Our curriculum, approach to pedagogy, wellbeing and culture works in harmony with the design of the school buildings.

A central feature of the design is a series of cascading bleachers that interconnect the various levels, while acting as informal learning and gathering spaces. The architecture of the school motivates physical movement, vertical circulation and open visibility. This together with the learning terraces and multiple breakout spaces creates a learning environment that aligns with our bespoke PHS Model of Learning. Our model includes various collaborative, flexible and independent learning pedagogies, along with an explicit focus on positive relationships and authentic wellbeing.

The ground floor houses the library, music and drama facilities. Science labs, art and design technology spaces extend throughout the next three levels, while learning spaces on each level open to outdoor learning terraces. The third floor features a full-sized basketball court gymnasium and an outdoor recreation zone. A multi-purpose area with café, seating and garden occupies the rooftop level.

The following points have helped to define our work together since Foundation. We look to build on these principles and beliefs as we progress. Please read these points, in conjunction with the detail on <u>our website</u> and honestly reflect on the strength of their personal accord with you.

- Our school culture is grounded in a genuine belief in the fundamental importance of relationships and a deep commitment to kindness and care. We explore this through our value of Character and through our evidence-based Positive Climate for Learning, underpinned by Unconditional Positive Regard, Positive Psychology and Empowerment.
- 2. We have high expectations of our students and ourselves. We understand that students learn much more effectively in a kind, positive environment. Behaviour moderation and improvement endeavours are grounded in positive, constructive relationships, restorative conversations and forgiveness. We have a unique relationships development framework we call 'Connecting Us'.
- 3. At Prahran High School, students have voice, choice and agency. We listen to our students because we want to hear their views, ideas and questions. We structure learning experiences which aim to provide meaningful opportunities for students to become agentic learners. We provide students with significant choice as we believe that choice is empowering and motivating for young people.
- 4. Learning and teaching is approached in a consistent manner across the school, supported by a guaranteed and viable curriculum. Teachers' and students' unique strengths are valued and encouraged. All teachers have responsibility to develop curriculum and we understand that curriculum development is never complete - it is ever-changing as the world changes. We expect teachers to follow our PHS pedagogical model, not as clones, but as consistent representatives of PHS practice.
- 5. The very best teachers understand that collaboration is key to our success. We simply cannot and should not work alone collaborative team practice is how we work best together. Teachers collaborate in Professional Learning Communities to ensure a laser-light focus on student learning improvement. Collaborative practice is the default it's how we work.
- 6. The best teachers understand the importance of effective communication. It might seem self-evident but it is not always the case. At Prahran High School we commit to accurate, respectful, responsive and timely communication with our students, colleagues and families. We adhere to a set of PHS communication protocols.
- 7. We are committed to exploring contemporary technologies to support learning. We are open to students guiding us in new technological directions. We believe that digital technologies can enhance learning and we also believe that meaningful learning intentions must guide the technologies we explore and embrace. The world around us changes rapidly, wildly and in ways we could never imagine. Staff at Prahran High School are agile, open to learning and understand that constant change is our world.



- 8. We are a proud, distinctly inner-city school and we take an inner-city perspective on our work together. Our school has a close relationship with our community. Students are encouraged to work alongside business and community groups to develop their entrepreneurial skills and to contribute.
